

Splits, lumps and shuffles

This latest instalment includes hybridisation between Harlequin and White-breasted antbirds (but perhaps no lump!); and potential splits in Ruddy Spinetail, Olivaceous Flatbill (including a newly described species!) and Bright-rumped Attila.
